Australasian College of Health Service Management (ACHSM)	22 September (workshops) – 5.5 points 23-24 September (full congress) – 10 points
Royal Australasian College of Medical Administrators (RACMA)	One point per hour, or a max of 8 points per day for conference attendance
Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RANZCOG)	<i>Other Meetings Category</i> – 1 point per hour of educational activity
